Region: Rhone Valley France

Taste Characteristics: Blackberry Blueberry Dark Fruit Pepper

Food Matching: Beef, Lamb, Poultry

Lovely tense and yet round plush black currant fruit with classic violet lift and hints of more-ish smoky tar. Gorgeous balance and length in this fine medium bodied offering.

Region: Grampians Victoria

Taste Characteristics: Blackberry Blueberry Dark Fruit Pepper

Food Matching: Beef, Lamb, Poultry

Mt Langi Ghiran Vineyards is a “maker of outstanding cool-climate peppery shiraz, crammed with flavour and vinosity” (Halliday). Look forward to a “big mouthful of flavour for a tiny price... 90pts” (Jeni Port, Halliday Wine Companion)..

Tahbilk Shiraz 2017 – 13.5%

Region: Nagambie Lakes, Goulburn Valley, Victoria

Taste Characteristics: Plum, blackcurrant, blueberries and blackberries, Oak, vanilla, pepper

Food Matching: Beef, Lamb, Poultry

Aromas of plums, spice and background peppery hints lead to a richly flavoured palate of blackberry, plum and anise fruits. Firm, supportive tannins will hold this release in good stead for further cellaring. Tahbilk is “a winery steeped in tradition” (Halliday). The 2017 Shiraz is “fresh and

lively” with “a nice cherry pip character to the medium-bodied flow of the wine.

Picardy Shiraz 2019 – 13.5%

Region: Pemberton WA

Taste Characteristics: Plum, Blackberry, Mulberry, pepper

Food Matching: Beef, Lamb, Hard Cheeses

A beautifully elegant form of Shiraz from Picardy displaying notes of red fruits, cracked black pepper and spice. A fresh, vibrant wine with suede like silky tannins and a wonderfully lingering finish.

Star Lane Beechworth Winery Shiraz 2018 – 14.2%

Region: Beechworth

Taste Characteristics: Blackberry and blackcurrant aromas with a whiff of liquorice and aniseed

This Shiraz is deep, generous and well balanced. It has a smooth, supple but rich and powerful palate. It has shy blackberry and blackcurrant aromas with a whiff of liquorice and aniseed combined with a very savoury palate and hints of oak spice. It has a seasoning of well-integrated French oak that is perfectly balanced with fruit that is well able to handle it.

Gibson The Dirtman Shiraz 2019 – 14.5%

Region: Barossa Valley South Australia

Taste Characteristics: Ripe blackberries, liquorice and dark chocolate vanillin oak, mocha and spice

Food Matching: Beef, Lamb, Poultry

Deep opaque red with purple hue. Lifted complex plum and spice characters on the nose with interesting notes of spicy oak. The palate is medium bodied full flavoured lively and well balanced. The finish is harmonious and long, leaving spicy dark chocolate cherry pip flavours lingering on the palate. It shows all the hallmarks of world-class Shiraz treated with good oak maturation to produce a great wine with good ageing potential.

Chapel Hill The Prophet Shiraz 2020 – 14.5%

Region: McLaren Vale, SA

Taste Characteristics: Vanilla, Oak, Plum, Cassis, Blueberry, pepper

Food Matching: Roast Pork, b

This McLaren Vale heavyweight is divinely good and shows Michael Pragos's wonderful handiwork at its very best. It brims with deep blueberry, mocha, dark olive and liquorice with a lovely mouthfeel, the fruit and tannins all in perfectly pitched harmony.

PepperGreen Estate Shiraz Cool Climate Regional Collection 2016 – 15%

Region: Orange NSW

Taste Characteristics: Medium deep red, with garnet on the edge. Ripe, sweet red plums on the nose.

Food Matching: Beef, Lamb

The wine reflects the cold nights and warm sunny days that enable our wines to consistently develop beautiful elegance with subtle fruit flavours. This full-bodied wine has a refined silky palate with shiny plum flavours.
